
These processes run parallel e.g. between the eye and the ear and the well directed control of arm and foot movement when driving a car.

Children with reading and spelling disabilities can have a problem differentiating between different high pitched sounds.


On the other hand abnormalities are often identified in the sphere of sight and motor activity. Affected persons often have a problem pressing a button on a given signal.


Biofeedback

Biofeedback



*Medi*TECH® offers in cooperation with the Canadian company 'Thought Technology' a variety of Biofeedback methods in the field of non-medicated therapy forms. With the help of these methods it is possible to measure and train numerous body functions. The learning processes which have been self-accomplished by the clients support sustainable therapeutic results.

Biofeedback is the response to the biological signals of the body which under normal conditions can be totally lost or only vaguely registered.

The actual procedure is as follows. The therapist attaches one or more sensors and electrodes to the patient's body depending on what the aim of the therapy is, these then make it possible to measure numerous different body functions. These include the reading or rather the training of the heart, breathing and muscle activity, the conductivity of the skin and the blood volume pulse. The signals received are then 'feedback' by computer either visually or audibly so that the patient is aware of them.

This creates a process, whereby a person can learn to improve their health, their performance and their wellbeing by watching their own body signals. It is possible for the patient to warm their hands, breath more evenly, control their blood pressure or relax muscle tension.


A special form of Biofeedback is Neurofeedback (EEG – Biofeedback). It allows one to gain even more self control over brain activity. Brainwaves are measured by an EEG – Sensor and converted via a computer programme into a form that the client can recognise (either graphic or audio). The client immediately sees on the monitor selected images that are visually or audibly a response to positive changes in his brain activity.

This 'success report' allows the client to achieve this state of brain activity more quickly and more constantly and eventually after a conscious learning process, without the use of sensors. During this process the brain is no longer supplied with electrical impulses, however the strength of the various brain waves is measured. Neurofeedback optimises the organisation of brain activity.

In contrast to conventional mental treatment or the use of medication, the training with Neurofeedback takes place in the form of inhibiting or strengthening exactly the right regions of the brain which are in need of support. There is no record to date of any negative side effects or complications.




